

Performing Choir Auditions Frequently Asked Questions

Will my daughter automatically be promoted to Performing Choir?

Each girl will be considered on an individual basis; no chorister is guaranteed a position in Performing Choir.

My daughter has previously had a leadership role/Stellata part. Will this be considered as part of the decision?

Previous experience will be considered, however it does not guarantee her an automatic place.

What is covered in the Performing Choir Audition?

The singing and dance auditions will include an assessment of vocal quality; level of independence when holding a vocal part; general musicianship; ability to absorb and perform complicated dance routines; stage and presentation skills. There is no need for girls to prepare anything beforehand as they will be asked to sing material from their current repertoire in a group and by themselves. Content for the dance component will be taught during the audition.

What other factors are taken into account when offering choristers a place in Performing Choir?

We consider each girl's displayed level of confidence in combination with her tutor's assessment of her social readiness; participation in lessons; ability to work within a team and capacity to work on complex repertoire and choreography. With this in mind, we would prefer to support girls who are still consolidating these skills by inviting them to continue in Concert Level for another year rather than them feeling overwhelmed and out of their depth if placed in Performing Choir too soon.

Is the final decision solely based on the audition on the day?

No, we take a holistic approach when making final decisions. We consider each chorister's participation, development and attendance over the course of the year and we are in close communication with their current tutor regarding their progress in these areas.

If my daughter is unsuccessful in her audition can she audition again in 12 months time?

Yes. Girls are invited to audition annually.

Can my daughter get feedback on her audition?

We promote clear and transparent communication and encourage parents to contact us for further individual feedback.
