



## Adelaide Senior Commitments 2022

This information applies to both Camerata and Performing Choir

### Commitment

In order for the choir to continue to reach, and surpass, the high standard of performance and presentation that we have attained, choristers in our senior levels must understand that choir commitments come directly after compulsory school engagements. We understand that busy and talented young women of the calibre of our senior choristers will always have many other interests, such as dance, instrumental lessons, or sporting commitments. It is important to establish an order of priorities. We expect 100% attendance at weekly rehearsals and other choir events and many choristers nationally achieve this. The minimum attendance rate that we are prepared to accept is 80%.

### Rehearsal Times and Venue

Both Camerata and Performing Choir rehearse at Seymour College, 546 Portrush Road, Glen Osmond on Thursday evenings from 6.30 – 9.00pm. We understand that for many choristers the location of this rehearsal venue will result in many kilometres and extra travel time each week. We believe that carpooling arrangements can help facilitate choristers travelling great distances in order to participate in these rehearsals. Rehearsals commence **Thursday February 3, 2022**.

### Costume and Uniform

The weekly rehearsal uniform for Camerata and Performing Choir consists of navy dance pants, a **navy t-shirt**, a magenta polar fleece and optional shorts. New Camerata choristers will need to purchase an AGC Backpack.

The Camerata and Performing Choir costume consists of black costume pants, a costume top, an AGC black senior performance t-shirt and black jazz shoes. It will be necessary for all new choristers to purchase the black costume pants at a cost of \$50 and a black senior performance t-shirt at a cost of \$20, at the beginning of 2022. Provision of the costume top is included in 2022 fees; costume tops will be on loan and need to be returned when girls leave the choir.

### Australian Girls Choir Concerts

Choristers in the senior levels are expected to participate in all Australian Girls Choir concerts throughout the year including the associated rehearsals – the Winter Showcase Concerts (June), AGC in Concert (August/September) and the Annual Concerts (November/December). Confirmed dates will be provided early next year. Should you be unable to attend one of the concerts, we ask that you please contact our office to discuss this.

### Public Engagements

Normally, we are invited to participate in a number of public engagements throughout the year and this requires a high level of commitment from girls and parents. On some occasions event organisers provide transport to and from the event, however for most engagements it is the responsibility of parents to organise their daughter's transport. The decision to participate in public engagements is at each parent's discretion; we encourage girls to make themselves available for public engagements unless there is a compulsory school event or family commitment that prevents this happening.

### Touring

Under normal circumstances we offer a two week National Tour in June/July and a three week International Tour in September/October. We are unable to make any plans at this stage but hope to be able to make some national touring plans in 2022. We will be in contact with all senior girls' parents as soon as we have a plan in place.

## Adelaide Senior Commitments 2022

### CAMERATA

#### Camerata 2022 Fees

The Camerata fees for 2022 are \$2,040. This fee incorporates participation in weekly classes; all extra combined rehearsals; the compulsory Music School; the provision of a coloured costume top for choir concerts and engagements; a costume bag and the loan of original notated sheet music.

#### Camerata Music School

##### Saturday March 19 and Sunday March 20

Attendance at the Music School is expected for all Camerata choristers. Non-attendance must be discussed with us prior to acceptance as a significant amount of work is covered over the two days and the Winter Showcase choreography item is learnt.

#### Extra Rehearsal Days

To prepare for engagements and concerts we will be holding four compulsory rehearsal days for Camerata throughout the year. Full attendance is expected. Dates and times will be confirmed early next year.

#### Full day weekend rehearsals:

**Standard Repertoire Rehearsal** – Held in late February

**AGC in Concert Production Rehearsal** – Held in August

**Carols Rehearsal Day** – Held in early September

**Annual Concert Production Rehearsal** – Held in October/November

#### Camerata Extension Activities

##### Leadership Positions

Early next year Tutors will select girls for the roles of Camerata Leaders, Dance Leader, Section Leaders and goz Community Leaders.

##### Camerata Dance Group – Danzare

All Camerata choristers may audition for Danzare at the beginning of 2022. Positions in Danzare only become available when girls leave Camerata. Rehearsals will take place between 5.45 – 6.30pm each Thursday evening and a fee of \$525 per year applies.

### PERFORMING CHOIR

#### Performing Choir 2022 Fees

The Performing Choir fees for 2022 are \$2,910. This fee incorporates participation in weekly classes; all extra combined rehearsals; the compulsory residential Music School; the provision of a costume top for choir concerts and engagements and the loan of original notated sheet music.

#### Performing Choir Music School

As you will have observed over the past 18 months, we are making event and concert plans well ahead of time as usual and adapting when COVID restrictions are announced. Like you, we're hoping that life in Australia will be looking significantly different by April 2022 and we're optimistic about being able to hold the Performing Choir Music Schools as outlined. Naturally, we'll change these plans if needs be and keep you posted.

#### The Tops Conference Centre, Stanwell Tops, NSW

Due to venue availability, we have had to schedule the first day of music school on Easter Monday. We apologise for any inconvenience this causes and appreciate your understanding.

The Music School has been a compulsory event since the choir's inception. Up to an extra term's intensive work is covered in this time and choreography items are learnt. We understand that conflicts can arise but the rule is and will remain the same; **girls who cannot attend this Music School are ineligible to be part of Performing Choir. No exceptions will be made.** It is our expectation that girls will remain on-site for the duration of this music school. We encourage you to contact us prior to re-enrolment if you have a conflicting commitment.

#### Extra Rehearsal Days

To prepare for engagements and concerts we will be holding four compulsory rehearsal days for Performing Choir throughout the year. Full attendance is expected. Dates and times will be confirmed early next year.

#### Full day weekend rehearsals:

**Standard Repertoire Rehearsal** – Held in late February

**AGC in Concert Production Rehearsal** – Held in August

**Carols Rehearsal Day** – Held in early September

**Annual Concert Production Rehearsal** – Held in October/November

#### Performing Choir Extension Activities and Awards

##### Scholarships, Leadership Positions and Awards

The Jean Oliver Choir Leader Scholarship and June Bronhill Vocal Potential Scholarship are awarded to Performing Choir members at the end of each year for the following year. Senior choristers are currently awarded leadership positions including Section Leaders, Dance Leader, Junior Specialist Leader and goz Community Leaders. We also present awards for excellence, contribution and performance.

##### Performing Choir Dance Group – Ballare

Choristers in Performing Choir must be in their second year or above to audition for Ballare. Positions in Ballare only become available when girls leave the choir and auditions will be held in February 2022. Rehearsals take place between 5.00 – 5.45pm each Thursday evening and a fee of \$600 per year applies.

##### Performing Choir – Bel Canto

Choristers in Performing Choir must be in their second year or above to be eligible for Bel Canto. Bel Canto is a select group of choristers and places only become available when girls leave the choir.

Choristers are offered a position based on their history with the choir and their voice placement results at the beginning of the year. Bel Canto rehearse each Thursday evening between 5.45 – 6.30pm. No extra fee is charged.
