- Strong leadership skills, with the ability to inspire and motivate young performers
- A passion for girls' education and the drive to champion the value of Performing Arts participation
- Piano accompanist skills (desired)
- A qualification in music and/or teaching (desired)

About the role:

This position will play a pivotal role in the development and leadership of our senior choristers (between the ages of 13 – 18) to enhance their aural, vocal and performance skills, and stage presence. This includes co-teaching and accompanying weekly classes on Thursday evenings during school terms, as well as working at AGC concerts & rehearsal weekends – this may include up to 8 weekends per year. The successful applicant will preferably attend our annual residential music school, which runs for approximately 5 days and falls during the April school holidays.

Applicants will have well-developed communication and interpersonal skills, ability to work within a team, as well as strong music and conducting skills and an interest in teaching wide-ranging repertoire that features dynamic staging and choreography.

As classes are extra-curricular most of our casual staff members hold full-time positions outside the AGC. Many of our tutors find that working with the AGC provides them with an opportunity to collaborate with a dynamic team of teaching professionals; complements their performance practice and contributes to their sense of personal achievement.
